EVANGELISM

Providing hope through the Gospel is and will always be our primary goal. We want to see our brothers and sisters in Haiti have a growing relationship with Jesus Christ. Over the 50 years we've partnered with over 100 churches. In 2023, 44 pastors led thousands in their congregations to serve over 22 communities and about 300 individuals gave their life to Christ.



EDUCATION

We have always focused very heavily on hope for brighter futures through education. By providing an education to our young people, their chances at success and helping to bring lasting change to the country increase dramatically. HCM's 10 schools impacted more than 2,800 youth in 2023.



HEALTH & WELLNESS

We seek to provide hope for those who are in need through medical care and the meeting of urgent, physical needs. Whether that's through nutrition programs or various medical services and procedures, those who are hurting know they can come to HCM's campus and find hope in whatever ways they are in need.

COMMUNITIES WE SERVE

We partner with 22 communities in Haiti, with two main hubs (pointed out on the map). Several communities are located in and around Port-Au-Prince, but most are in very rural villages.

HCM KEY MILESTONES

- 1974 ● The ministry of HCM officially launched on the front porch of a rented home.
- 1976 ● The first church was built in Port Au Prince. Over 50 churches have followed the same path.
- 1977 ● The ministry in Fonds Parisien was started with a church, nutrition center, and a school.
- 1981 ● Christ For All Hospital opened its doors.
- 2008 ● God blessed us with a maternity ward that was able to save thousands after the earthquake and it continues to deliver over 800 babies a year.
- 2010 ● Fonds Parisien becomes the main campus post-earthquake.
- 2013 ● The Nutrimamba Peanut Butter Factory was created to tackle malnutrition and protein deficiency in the communities we serve.
- 2016 ● The Higgins Brothers Surgicenter for Hope was built.
- 2024 ● The mission celebrates it's 50th anniversary.



ABOUT THE MISSION

As an organization that follows Jesus Christ, Haitian Christian Mission exists to create communities throughout Haiti where hope can thrive. 450+ Haitian staff do this in the country through evangelism, education, health, and wellness.

HOW IT BEGAN

The late Pastor Etienne Prophete and his wife, Betty, started HCM in their home with Bible studies and prayer meetings in 1974. As they saw all the needs around them, they incorporated education, nutrition, and healthcare into their ministry. As other churches were planted, the outreach continued to grow. In 2010, Edwens Prophete replaced his father as CEO of HCM.
